### **Ashtrees**

Our seed is **obtained from and grown in the U.K.** whilst this is significantly more expensive than seed imported from abroad, it does mean that the trees that we produce are free of Ash Die Back fungus and are suitable for the U.K climate.

Cell grown plants have **slow release fertilizers added** to the growing medium, this helps the tree in the 1<sup>st</sup> few years after planting, the growth and health of the tree is greatly increased compared to bare rooted plants.

Our plants are **grown in a controlled environment**, compact and even growth is achieved and results in stock that is easier to plant than bare rooted trees.

We do not cut the roots off our trees, they are not damaged by heavy machinery and the plant is supplied with all the roots that it had throughout its time on the nursery resulting in a more fibrous root system, giving you better establishment success.

Many of our customers now solely use cell grown plants. If you decide to do the same, I am sure you will not be disappointed.

An \* next to the English name indicates that the plant is native to the U.K as defined by the Forestry Commission.

Prices stated are wholesale ex-nursery & subject to change without notice. All prices are subject to V.A.T at the prevailing rate.

### Cell Grown plants are supplied and charged in multiples of 15. A 20% surcharge will be added for less than 15 of any one variety.

All orders must be confirmed in writing.

The seller shall retain ownership of all goods supplied until all monies due and owing by the customer are paid in full.

The risk of goods shall pass to the customer upon delivery or collection by the customer's own carrier.

All items are offered subject to availability

Payment from customers without an account must be made on collections or before despatch.

#### Payment for non-account holders is due upon receipt of invoice.

Payment for account holders is due within 28 days of the invoice date.

Interest of 10% per month **WILL** be levied on late payments.

Customers wishing to open a credit account should apply in writing enclosing two trade and one banker's reference. A credit account will be opened at our discretion and a credit limit fixed at the time.

Unless stated carriage will be charged at cost.

The seller shall not be liable for failure to deliver goods outside of the seller's control.

Should the customer in whole or part cancel an order, we reserve the right to charge up to 100% of the order value.

Whilst every effort is made to supply stock of the highest quality, no warranty shall be given or implied as to the description, quality or growth. The Seller shall not be responsible for the condition or quality of the goods after delivery by the Seller or collection by the customer or for any contingent or consequential loss.

All sizes are approximate.

Consignments must be carefully examined on receipt and any complaint notified by telephone within 2 days and confirmed in writing within 5 days. Failure to do so will render any complaint void.

The placing of an order implies acceptance of the seller's terms, which shall be governed by English law. These terms shall have priority over any other conditions of purchase stated by the customer.
